PROCEDURES PERFORMED AND NOT PERFORMED

Procedures Performed in Clinic

- 1. Application and adjustment of Halos
- 2. Apply casts, some may require special techniques
- 3. Apply Unna Boot
- 4. Aspiration of ganglion cyst
- 5. Dressing change
- 6. Incision and drainage
- 7. Injections of joints of patients with bursitis, tendinitis, etc.
- 8. Remanipulation of fractures
- 9. Removal of casts
- 10. Removal of foreign bodies
- 11. Removal of pins
- 12. Removal of toenails
- 13. Suture and staple removal
- 14. Therapeutic blocks and Trigger Point injections
- 15. Wedging of casts
- 16. Wound debridement

Procedures Not Performed in Clinic

- 1. Initial trauma fractures are seen and treated in emergency room
- 2. Set fractures that are complicated
- 3. Stellate block
- **Note:** Procedures may be performed under conscious sedation when deemed appropriate by the physicians.
